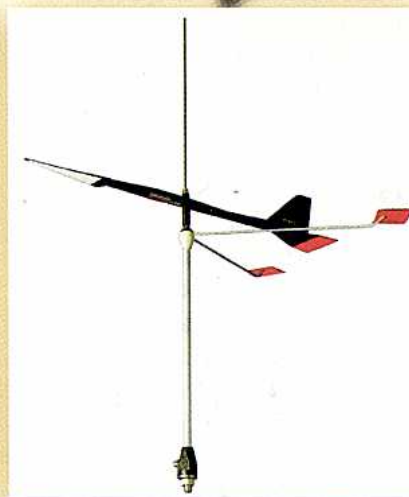
## Wanna Hang Out?
